What is a typical day at ReachforChange?

A typical morning starts around 9am when you arrive to our office in Gamla Stan, the center of Stockholm. You will review your tasks of the day that might include research, product development, event coordination to communication through social media. Finally, you will organise with the four other interns fun team activities for the whole team such as breakfasts, fika and afterworks. The day usually finishes at 5pm but work hours are flexible. Each week, you will have a check-in with your supervisor in order to discuss your next steps.
