What we can offer

Your work would support our incubator which is a direct connection with our smart, brave and passionate social entrepreneurs and the children that they are empowering. You will also be responsible of your own project called a red thread. The red thread project is your own assignment start to finish and you can plan this with your supervisor.

What is a typical day at Reach for Change?

A typical morning starts around 9am when you arrive to our office in Gamla Stan, the center of Stockholm. The work varies from managing your own projects to aiding and running bigger events. Specific examples include running Change Leader day, where all of our Swedish Change Leaders come together for knowledge sharing and development; supporting our global award summit Child 10 Awards or running our Pitch Nights together with our partner companies. You will also organise with other interns fun team activities for the whole office such as breakfasts, fika and afterworks. The day usually finishes at 5pm but you are also responsible of your work hours. You will have a check-in with your supervisor in order to discuss your next steps and to have help supporting your development.
