What is a typical day at ReachforChange?

You will work closely with our Accounting Manager who leads the work and manages the closings in our five different bookkeeping entities (Sweden, Ghana, Ethiopia, Bulgaria & Kazakhstan). As the single point of contact for IT request, it will also be your job to coordinate, plan and instruct the outsourced IT development team in how to solve the various needs most effectively. Finally, you will organise with the four other interns fun team activities for the whole team such as breakfasts, fika and afterworks. The day usually finishes at 5pm but work hours are flexible. Each week, you will have a check-in with your supervisor in order to discuss your next steps.
